Gerry,

I apologize for the delayed response. Per our discussion this is a budget to continue inspections on the Reservoir Replacement project and to assist with permit closeout. My understanding is that you are starting to irrigate the seeded areas of the site. It is my hope that the spec'd seed will germinate and grow enough over the next month to achieve final stabilization. The SWPPP permit requires growth of this seed to 70% coverage of the seeded disturbed areas. Coverage is a bit subjective, but we have a significant experience with closing these permit and we will prepare the Notice of Termination (NOT) as soon as we see the growth that is necessary. We priced this budget based upon a completion and closeout date of November 15th.
