It's been heart break after heart break as I've had to rebuild it from the studs out and plow all the way through my savings. I finally moved into the house back in May (five months pregnant) and was so excited, Until the next wave of heart break hit when my spouse left me and I discovered that my water well wouldn't produce enough water to use anything in the house. My current well when inspected last year was producing about 3.5 gallons per minute which was already the minimum but now it's dredging up green clay and sediment and my house water is green and muddy even after having Sierra pipe come out about half a dozen times and a real fancy water treatment plant installed in my garage. The well itself is just too old and dried up. Two days ago when the new filtration system clogged up with clay I had my well diagnosed and it is a loss. I need to drill a new well to the tune of too much money that I don't have.

It is my hope that I could plug into Christian Valley Water supply and use that utility instead of investing in a new well.
